



Acts 7



⁸ Now Stephen, a man full of **God's grace and power, performed great wonders and signs** among the people.

⁹ Opposition arose, however, from members of the Synagogue of the Freedmen (as it was called)—Jews of Cyrene and Alexandria as well as the provinces of Cilicia and Asia—who began to argue with Stephen. ¹⁰ But they could not stand up against the wisdom the Spirit gave him as he spoke.

¹¹ Then they secretly persuaded some men to say, “We have heard Stephen speak blasphemous words against Moses and against God.”

¹² So they stirred up the people and the elders and the teachers of the law. They **seized Stephen** and brought him before the Sanhedrin.

¹³ They produced **false** witnesses, who testified, “This fellow never stops speaking against this holy place and against the law.

14 For we have heard him say that this Jesus of Nazareth will destroy this place and change the customs Moses handed down to us.”

15 All who were sitting in the Sanhedrin looked intently at Stephen, and they saw that his **face** was like the **face** of an **angel**. Then the high priest asked Stephen, “Are these charges true?”



9 “Because the **Patriarchs** were **JEALOUS** of Joseph, they sold him as a slave into Egypt. But God was with him

v. 25 Moses thought that his **OWN PEOPLE** would **REALIZE** that **God** was **USING** him to rescue them, but **they did NOT**.

v. 35 “This is the same Moses they had **REJECTED** with the words, ‘Who made you ruler and judge?’ **He** was **SENT** to be their **Ruler** and **Deliverer** by **GOD HIMSELF**

v. 39 “But our ancestors **REFUSED** to **OBEDIENT** him.

51 “You stiff-necked people! Your hearts and ears are still uncircumcised.

You are **just** like your **ancestors**:

You **Always RESIST** the Holy Spirit!

v. 52 Was there **EVER** a **Prophet** your **Ancestors** did
NOT Persecute?

v. 53 you who have **received** the **law** that was given through angels
but have **NOT Obeyed** it.”

54 When the members of the Sanhedrin heard this, they were **Furious** and **Gnashed** their **Teeth** at him.




55 But Stephen,

looked up to heaven and

saw the **Glory** of God,



and **Jesus**
standing at the
right hand of God.



56 “**Look**,” he said, “I see
heaven open and the
Son of Man standing at the
right hand of God.”



57 At this they **covered** their **ears** and, **yelling** at the **top** of their **voices**, they all rushed at him,



58 **dragged** him out of the city and began to **stone** him.



Meanwhile, the witnesses laid their **coats** at the **feet** of a young man named **Saul**.



59 While they were **stoning**
him, Stephen **prayed**,
“Lord Jesus,
receive my spirit.”



60 Then he fell on his knees
and cried out,

“Lord, do **NOT HOLD**
this **sin against them.**”
