

Every N.T. Bible Verse on Fear Related to God!

1. Hebrews 12:28-29 We may **serve God acceptably** with **reverence** and **godly fear**. 29 For our **God** is a **consuming fire**.
2. Romans 11:20 Quite right, they were broken off for their unbelief, but you stand by your faith Do not be conceited, but **fear**;
3. Philippians 2:12 So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, **work out your salvation** with **fear** and **trembling**;
4. 1 Peter 1:17 If you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves in **fear** during the time of your stay on earth;
5. Matthew 10:28 "Do not **fear** those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather **fear** Him who is able to **destroy both soul and body in hell**.
6. Matthew 28:8 And they left the tomb quickly with **fear** and great joy and ran to report it to His disciples.
7. Mark 10:32 Jesus was walking on ahead of them; and they were amazed, and those who followed were **fearful**. And again He took the twelve aside and began to tell them what was going to happen to Him,
8. Luke 1:50 " AND HIS MERCY IS UPON GENERATION AFTER GENERATION TOWARD THOSE WHO **FEAR** HIM.
9. Luke 5:26 They were all struck with astonishment and began glorifying God; and they were filled with **fear**, saying, "We have seen remarkable things today."
10. Luke 7:16 **Fear** gripped them all, and they began glorifying God, saying, "A great prophet has arisen among us!" and, "God has visited His people!"
11. Luke 8:25 And He said to them, "Where is your faith?" They were **fearful** and amazed, saying to one another, "Who then is this, that He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey Him?"
12. Luke 8:37 And all the people of the country of the Gerasenes and the surrounding district asked Him to leave them, for they were gripped with great **fear**; and He got into a boat and returned.

13. Luke 12:5 "But I will warn you whom to **fear: fear** the One who, after He has killed, has authority to cast into hell; yes, I tell you, **fear** Him!
14. Luke 23:40 But the other answered, and rebuking him said, "Do you not even **fear** God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation?"
15. John 9:31 "We know that God does not hear sinners; but if anyone is **God-fearing** and does His will, He hears him.
16. Acts 5:5 And as he heard these words, Ananias fell down and breathed his last; and great **fear** came over all who heard of it.
17. Acts 5:11 And great **fear** came over the whole church, and over all who heard of these things.
18. Acts 7:32 ' I AM THE GOD OF YOUR FATHERS, THE GOD OF ABRAHAM AND ISAAC AND JACOB.' Moses shook with **fear** and would not venture to look.
19. Acts 9:31 So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria enjoyed peace, being built up; and going on in the **fear** of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it continued to increase.
20. Acts 10:2 a devout man and one who **feared** God with all his household, and gave many alms to the Jewish people and prayed to God continually.
21. Acts 10:22 They said, "Cornelius, a centurion, a righteous and **God-fearing** man well spoken of by the entire nation of the Jews
22. Acts 10:35 but in every nation the man who **fears** Him and does what is right is welcome to Him.
23. Acts 13:16 Paul stood up, and motioning with his hand said, "Men of Israel, and you who **fear** God, listen:
24. Acts 13:26 "Brethren, sons of Abraham's family, and those among you who **fear** God, to us the message of this salvation has been sent.
25. Acts 13:43 Now when the meeting of the synagogue had broken up, many of the Jews and of the **God-fearing** proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas, who, speaking to them, were urging them to continue in the grace of God.
26. Acts 17:4 And some of them were persuaded and joined Paul and Silas, along with a large number of the **God-fearing** Greeks and a number of

the leading women.

27. Acts 17:17 So he was reasoning in the synagogue with the Jews and the **God-fearing** Gentiles
28. Acts 19:17 This became known to all, both Jews and Greeks, who lived in Ephesus; and **fear** fell upon them all and the name of the Lord Jesus was being magnified.
29. Romans 3:18 " THERE IS NO **FEAR** OF GOD BEFORE THEIR EYES."
30. Romans 8:15 For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to **fear** again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, " Abba! Father!"
31. Romans 13:7 Render to all what is due them: tax to whom tax is due; custom to whom custom; **fear** to whom **fear**; honor to whom honor.
32. 2 Cor. 5:10-11 For we must **all appear** before the **judgment seat of Christ** that each one may receive what is due him for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad. Therefore, **knowing** the **fear** of the Lord
33. 2 Corinthians 7:1 Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the **fear** of God.
34. 2 Cor 7:5 For even when we came into Macedonia our flesh had no rest, but we were afflicted on every side: conflicts without, **fears** within.
35. 2 Corinthians 7:11 For behold what earnestness this very thing, this godly sorrow, has produced in you: what vindication of yourselves, what indignation, what **fear**, what longing, what zeal, what avenging of wrong! In everything you demonstrated yourselves to be innocent in the matter.
36. 2 Corinthians 7:15 His affection abounds all the more toward you, as he remembers the obedience of you all, how you received him with **fear** and **trembling**.
37. Galatians 2:2 It was because of a revelation that I went up; and I submitted to them the gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but I did so in private to those who were of reputation, for **fear** that I might be running, or had run, in vain.

38. Ephesians 5:21 and be subject to one another in the **fear** of Christ.
39. Ephesians 6:5 Slaves, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with **fear** and **trembling**, in the sincerity of your heart, as to Christ;
40. Colossians 3:22 Slaves, in all things obey those who are your masters on earth, not with external service, as those who merely please men, but with sincerity of heart, **fearing** the Lord.
41. 1 Timothy 5:20 Those who continue in sin, rebuke in the presence of all, so that the rest also will be **fearful** of sinning.
42. Hebrews 4:1 Therefore, let us **fear** if, while a promise remains of entering His rest, any one of you may seem to have come short of it.
43. Hebrews 12:21 And so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, "I AM FULL OF **FEAR** and trembling."
44. 1 Peter 2:17 Honor all people, love the brotherhood, **fear** God
45. 1 John 4:18 There is no **fear** in love; but perfect love casts out **fear**, because **fear** involves punishment, and the one who **fears** is not perfected in love.
46. Jude 1:23 save others, snatching them out of the fire; and on some have mercy with **fear**, hating even the garment polluted by the flesh.
47. Revelation 11:11 But after the three and a half days, the breath of life from God came into them, and they stood on their feet; and great **fear** fell upon those who were watching them.
48. Revelation 11:18 "And the nations were enraged, and Your wrath came, and the time came for the dead to be judged, and the time to reward Your bond-servants the prophets and the saints and those who **fear** Your name, the small and the great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth."
49. Revelation 14:7 and he said with a loud voice, " **Fear** God, and give Him glory, because the hour of His judgment has come;
50. Revelation 15:4 " Who will not **fear**, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy
51. Revelation 18:10 standing at a distance because of the **fear** of her torment, saying, ' Woe, woe, the great city, Babylon, the strong city! For in one

hour your judgment has come.'

52. Revelation 18:15 "The merchants of these things, who became rich from her, will stand at a distance because of the **fear** of her torment
53. Rev 19:5 And a voice came from the throne, saying, " Give praise to our God, all you His bond-servants, you who **fear** Him
